

**Opportunity:** To shape how and where park is used after dark.

**Constraint:** Balance flexibility of park use with need to control, monitor and police activities.

**Opportunity:** To increase perceived security for park visitors.

**Constraint:** Need to balance quality and intensity of light for security without excessive light pollution or light levels reminiscent of sports venues or prisons. Light fixtures should not distract from views.



**Opportunity:** To open visual and physical linkage from the Village along Girard.

**Constraint:** Balance increased access with increased traffic levels; accommodate parking.

**Opportunity:** To create a more inviting park presence through lighting.

**Constraint:** Balance lighting needs with excessive light levels, light pollution, an ongoing maintenance costs.

**Opportunity:** To enhance pedestrian access ways and increase perceived security for park visitors.

**Constraint:** Balance access with public noise and disturbance and with excessive need to patrol and monitor pedestrian pathways after dusk.
